Pittsburgh Pipeline is a career exploration program for high school students to develop work ethics and an awareness of career opportunities that focus on the water industry. LSSE's Ned Mitrovich, P.E. and Larry Lennon, Jr.,

P.E. provided an overview of the engineering profession and led over 35 high school students from the Pittsburgh School

District through several activities / experiments to increase their knowledge and interest in water quality and treatment.

One of the students who attended the first event, Sarah Kucic, wrote the following about her experience at LSSE.

"The pipeline internees and I had a wonderful time doing this project [water filtration experiment] ... After lunch, we headed to a nearby creek to time the flow of water by dropping an orange into the water. The Pipeline internees really enjoyed this activity ... a very enlightening topic that caught the interest of several students."

### Lawrence J. Lennon to receive National WEF Award in New Orleans

Lawrence J. Lennon, P.E. D.WRE, has been selected by the WEF Board of Trustees as this year's recipient of the WEF Collection Systems Published Contributions Award for the paper entitled "Green Infrastructure Opportunities in Gray Wet Weather Plans."

This paper presented the findings of feasibility level assessments to determine the viability of developing site specific Green Infrastructure (GI) projects as a component of a large regional CSO Long Term Control Plan. The paper also describes a new approach to Collection System source flow reduction assessment and alternatives analysis that consider the location, capital cost, and effectiveness of incorporating specific identifiable municipally owned and operated GI control alternatives (GI vs Gray) into a LTCP.

Larry will be accepting the award as the Primary Author of this paper. The Awards

and Presidential Reception and Ceremony will be taking place on Tuesday, September 30, 2014 in New Orleans at the WEFTEC annual conference.

On August 7, 2014, LSSE reviewed the new National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) requirements and the Community Rate System (CRS) with several clients. The CRS recognizes community efforts and activities that help reduce flood insurance rates, but communities


# PA Report Card


The American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) provides a Report Card on Pennsylvania's Infrastructure and how it is doing at www.pareportcard.

The Pennsylvania Legislation has taken steps toward improving highway infrastructure by recently passing the Transportation Bill. This is just the beginning as other infrastructures are in need





ments and ASCE recommendations that can be followed to improve Pennsylvania's infrastructure.


